Qualifications:

- Graduation from a recognized college or university with a degree or equivalent in psychology, sociology and/or addictions, preferably in the counselling service sector or any combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, ability and skills.
- Supervisory skills.
- Ability to demonstrate good assessment skills, writing skills and interpersonal communications skills.
- Must be willing to receive further training as identified
- A demonstrated positive role model for staff, clients and the communities at large.
- Ability to motivate staff and clients.
- Good written and oral communication skills.
- Must demonstrate maintenance of a minimum two years sobriety.
- Understanding and knowledge of Traditional methods of healing and related practices is considered an asset.
- General knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal history, culture, traditions, ceremonies, principals and values.
- To have a First Nations language would be considered a valuable asset.
- Must have reliable vehicle and the appropriate Mb Driver's License including Class (4)IV Driver's.
- Must adhere to requirements for all the necessary checks i.e. Criminal Record, Child Abuse Registry and Prior Contact.
