The Teacher becomes an integral part of the Clinical Team and is responsible for providing children and youth with learning opportunities and educational support for each seven week treatment program.

Employment Requirements:

- Minimum of four years' experience working with First Nations children/youth with an understanding of the challenges young people may present in attending treatment programming with their family.
- Ability to accommodate and ensure the learning needs of varying grade levels is met.
- Must have a holistic approach to teaching children and youth for educational requirements including fostering their Aboriginal identity, spiritual growth and emotional well-being.
- Demonstrate a working awareness of the impacts of colonization on Indigenous families.
- Ability to implement traditional teachings in classroom with assistance and support of Elders and Cultural Helpers.
- Emotional maturity to effectively address and cope in crisis situations.
- Excellent written and verbal communication and presentation skills with students, parents and as part of Clinical Team.
- Proficient computer skills and knowledgeable in technology.
- Experience in counselling and work related knowledge of addictions would be an asset.
- An Education Degree or Manitoba Teaching Certificate from a recognized university or college. Please provide a copy of same along with your resume.
- Must adhere to Oath of Confidentiality and Code of Professional Conduct of the Centre.
- Have a valid Class V Driver's License and willing to obtain Class IV as part of ongoing employment.
- A valid Emergency First Aid / CPR certificate.
- Provide current Criminal Record and Child Abuse Registry Checks.
